## Partnerships



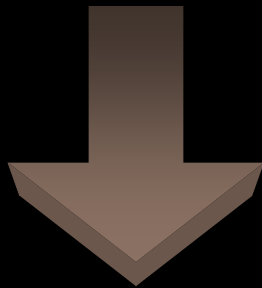
- Success will require shared leadership.

- FWS will continue to focus on the GLRC, consistent priorities, and a shared score card to measure progress.



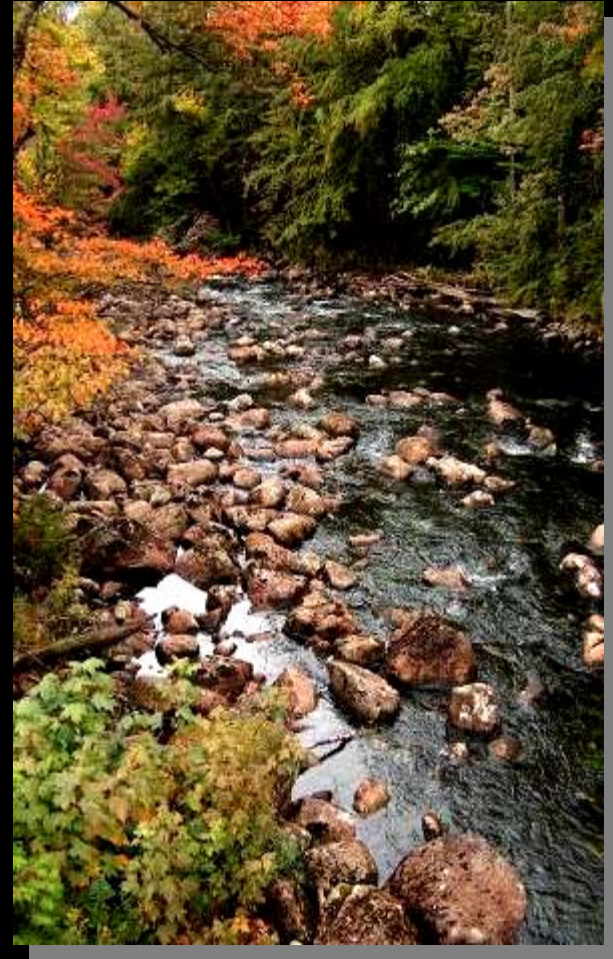

# Great Lakes Restoration Initiative:

## TOXIC SUBSTANCES & AREAS OF CONCERN

**\$5.4 M**



- Remediation & Restoration of Contaminated Sediments **\$760 K**
- Early Warning Program to Detect and Identify Emerging Contaminants and Effects on Fish & Wildlife **\$1.4 M**
- GLLA Sediment Removal Projects, Habitat Restoration & NRDA **\$440 K**
- Develop and implement a closure plan for the Grassy Island Unit of the Detroit River International Wildlife Refuge **\$2.8 M**



# Great Lakes Restoration Initiative:

## INVASIVE SPECIES

**\$19.859 M**

- Aquatic Invasive Species Prevention Program **\$3.136 M**
- Integrated Pest Management Grant/Subcontract Support **\$4.223 M**
- Integrated Pest Management for Priority Species **\$1.5 M**
- State and Interstate Aquatic Nuisance Species Management **\$11 M**



# Great Lakes Restoration Initiative:

HABITAT WILDLIFE PROTECTION & RESTORATION

\$32.242 M



- Implementation of the Great Lakes Fish & Wildlife Restoration Act \$8 M
- Great Lakes Habitat & Species Restoration Initiative \$5 M
- North American Wetlands Conservation Act \$2.5 M
- Restoration of lake trout & lake sturgeon in the Great Lakes \$7.742 M



# Great Lakes Restoration Initiative:

## HABITAT WILDLIFE PROTECTION & RESTORATION

- Great Lakes Wind Power: Making it Migratory Bird Friendly \$1 M
- Conservation of Great Lakes Islands \$1.5 M
- Habitat Assessment and Accounting Infrastructure \$2 M
- Great Lakes Basin Fish Habitat Partnership \$1.5 M
- Great Lakes Basin Endangered Species Recovery Initiative \$2 M
- Great Lakes Landscape Conservation Cooperative \$1 M



# Great Lakes Restoration Initiative:

## USFWS Funding – Mechanisms for Distribution

- ✓ IDIQ Cost Share Contracts (DU)
  - ✓ Contracts with full and open competition
  - ✓ Set aside contracts (small business, minority, etc.)
  - ✓ GSA Schedule
  - ✓ Cooperative Agreements
  - ✓ Use agreements with States and municipal agencies.
  - ✓ Agreements with other federal agencies.

- Up to **\$36.8 M** available for grants and cooperative agreements in FY 2010
