Lodging

There is a \$20 charge for the field trip and picnic and advance registration is required.

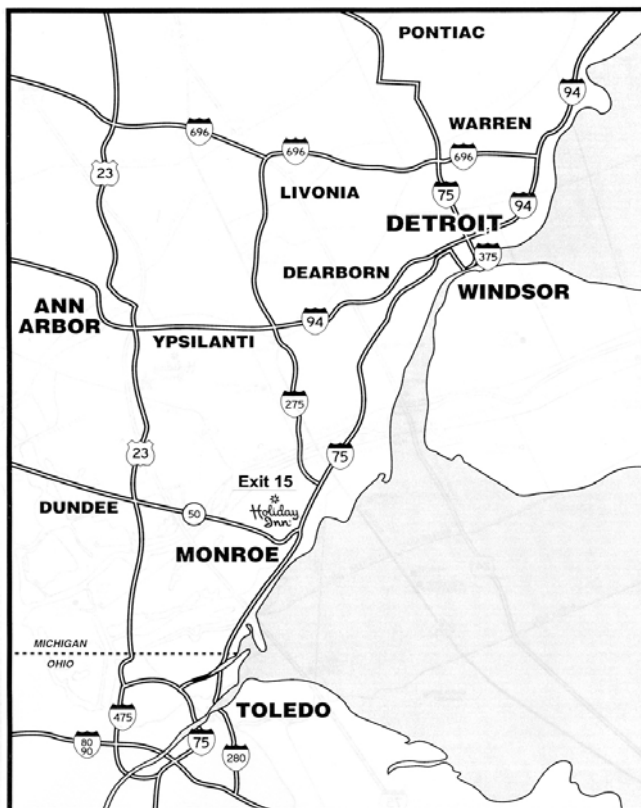
