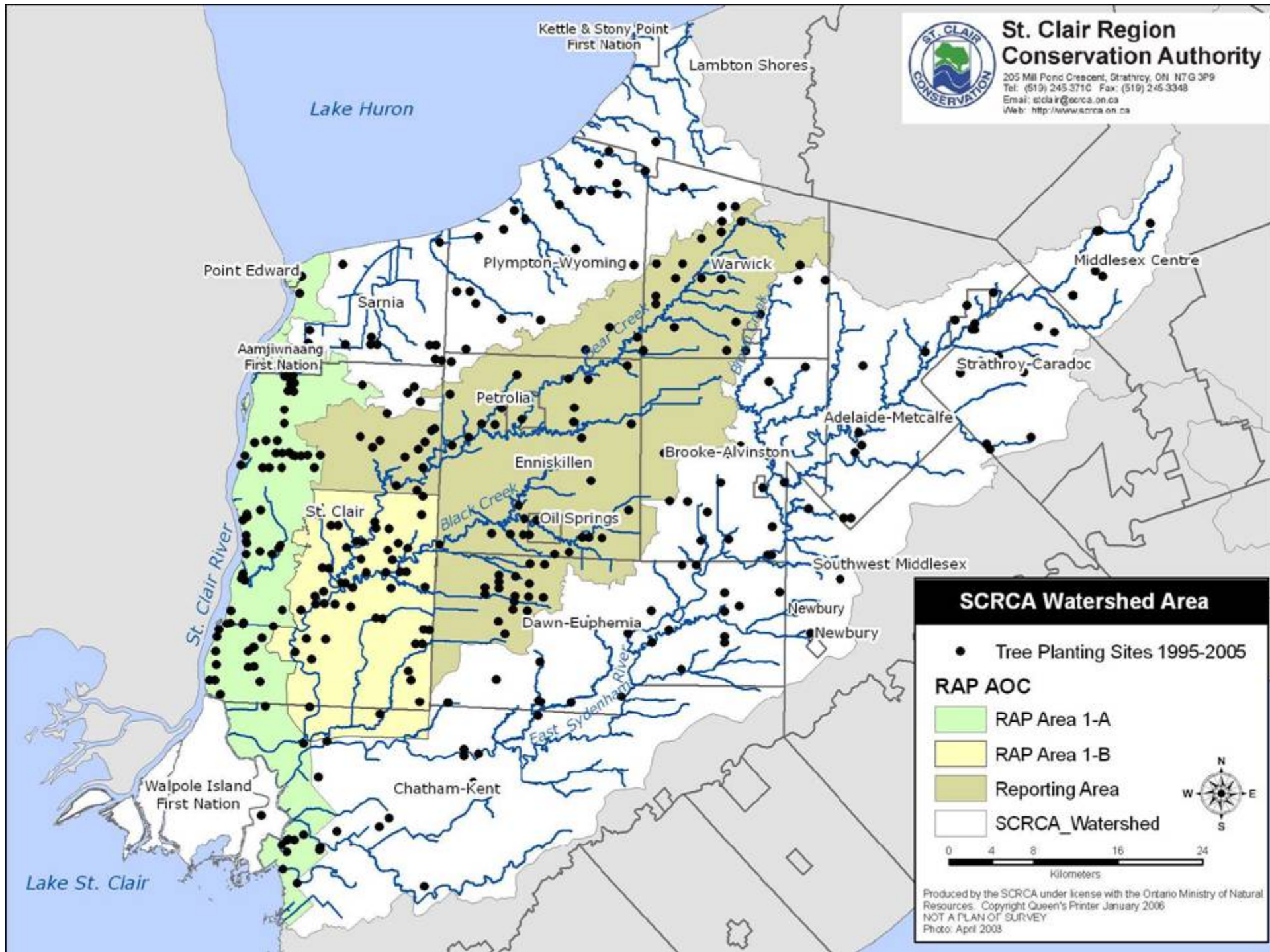

Federal Legislation

- All Pesticides in Canada must be registered under Pest Control Products Act. -administered by Health Canada
- Pesticides are divided into Divided into 6 Schedules (classes)
- Some like Raid and original Roundup are currently available anywhere without a license. They are schedule 6 pesticides
- Others require specific Licenses

Provincial

- All applicators are licensed under the Ontario Pesticides Act enforced by the Ontario Ministry of Environment.
- Licenses are type specific :
- Structural - 7 classes of license
- Land- 5 classes - agriculture, landscape, etc
- Aerial application is a special license

As far as phragmites is concerned there is no product registered for aerial application in Canada
