- Examples: salt, fertilizer, soaps, pet poop





Residential Stormwater Credits

Credit Type	Volume Captured	Examples	Kitchener Credit	Waterloo Credit
Basic Residential Credit	200 - 800 L	1-4 rain barrels; small cistern	20%	9-18%
Normal Residential Credit	801 - 3200 L	Large cistern; cistern + rain barrels	30%	27-36%
Enhanced Residential Credit	3201 L or more	Large cistern; infiltration gallery; permeable paving	45%	45%

Residential Credits

Building Footprint:	226 m ²	
Annual Charge:	\$126/year	
Credit (up to 45%):	\$57/year

Cities of Kitchener and Waterloo Commercial and Institutional Credits

- ♦ Up to 45% credit on monthly stormwater fee
 - 25% volume controls
 - 15% quality controls
 - 5% education
- City of Waterloo annual \$250 application fee, \$0 fee for Kitchener

Commercial Credits

Impervious Area: 74,336 m² Monthly Charge: \$2,196.90/month

Credit (up to 45%): \$988.60/month

The more you pave, the more you pay!




