

Highlighting our 2024 Grant Recipients

The Great Lakes AIS "Landing Blitz" is a binational multi-agency yearly effort aimed at raising public awareness and promoting actions to prevent the spread of harmful aquatic invasive species (AIS). In 2024, the Great Lakes Commission awarded more than \$50,000 to local organizations in the Great Lakes region to host their own Landing Blitz event! The seven organizations awarded helped educate boaters about the spread AIS and demonstrated proper cleaning of watercraft.

- Grant recipients held Landing Blitz events at 55 different locations across the Great Lakes basin. At these locations, staff, and volunteers educated over 4,000 people about AIS! In addition, over 2,000 boaters were educated on proper AIS inspections and boat cleaning
